Our investigation of your area conducted on February 27, 2008, indicates that there is still a small amount of methane gas in your water supply. Iron, manganese, turbidity, and hardness are elevated above drinking water standards in your supply. Because this is the case, the Department has determined that your water supply is affected by oil and gas well drilling. You will be contacted by the gas well operator, First Alliance Church, in order for them to make arrangements to replace your water supply as outlined in the Oil and Gas Act. Options for replacement will be discussed with you at that time. DEP will continue to monitor your complaint until your water supply replacement is complete. The analyses are enclosed for your records.
